Notice of Holding the 2020 World Robot Contest

The World Robot Contest has been held for five years since its premiere in 2015, attracting a total of over 120,000 contestants from more than 20 countries. It is an official professional event in the robotics field with extensive influence, and has been widely acclaimed as the “Olympics” by mainstream media of the robotics field.

Based on former experiences, focusing on the hi-tech communication, technology industrial application and the market scale impact, the 2020 World Robot Contest sets four contests around scientific research, skills and science popularization: Tri-Co Robot Challenge, BCI Controlled Robot Contest, Industrial Robot Contest, and Youth Design Contest. The Contest aims at offering contestants a global open platform that gathers around innovative resources, industrial resources and hi-tech human resources to stimulate technological research

potential of the robotics industry and to cultivate innovative global talents in robotics technology.

Adhering to the principles of public welfare, voluntariness and equality, we promise that the 2020 World Robot Contest is not intended to charge registration fees, gain profits, force or induce any school, student or parent to participate.
